What is sin?



Jesus the way to the Father

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you really know me, you will know my Father as well. From now on, you do know him and have seen him."

Jesus, in other words, is the bridge that connects us to God. Without Jesus , we would live in sin and not be forgiven of our sins. Through Jesus, we can have a relationship with God and live forever with Him in Heaven!



We believe every child can have a personal relationship with Jesus Christ. Only through Jesus can we receive salvation from our sins. We want your children to learn about Jesus, but also to make the decision for themselves that Jesus is their Lord and Savior!

We advise parents to allow their child to come to this decision themselves. This is a BIG decision that may take longer to fully grasp than expected. That's okay!

We have created a list of questions and answers that you can use to determine if your child has made the decision to follow Jesus.

1. Who is Jesus?

"Jesus is the Son of God who came down to earth to die on the cross for my sins so that I could have eternal life"

2. Why did Jesus die for you?

"Jesus died for me so that I could be forgiven of all of my sins. He died for me because He loves me."

3. Have you accepted Jesus into your life?

"I have accepted Jesus into my life, and I have asked Him to be my Lord and Savior."

1. Water Baptism

If your child has made the decision to follow Jesus, then their next step is Water Baptisms. Water baptism is an outward picture of what Jesus has done for us on the inside of our heart. Water Baptism is telling the world that we belong to Jesus.

If your child is ready to be Water Baptized or you aren't quite sure, we encourage you to read our FFC Kids Baptism Guide with your child to talk about the meaning of Water Baptism and to discern if your child is ready to be Water Baptized.
