Preschool

Designed specifically for children six-weeks-old through kindergarten, our Nursery/Preschool services are a place for our youngest generation to learn about the love of Christ.

During service, your child will engage in a thoughtfully-planned learning experience reinforced with songs, Bible stories, and activities.

Elementary

First-through-fourth grade children will have the opportunity to engage in dynamic worship and biblical teaching through our grade-specific learning model.

During service, children will spend most of their time in a Small Group to give them the benefit of a consistent Small Group Leader and interaction with kids their age.

Together, they'll learn about the Bible and how to have a relationship with God, memorize Scripture, and have fun developing friendships with one another.

What to Expect

Check-In

To make your first visit as easy as possible, we have created both an online and in-person registration process for you and your family. During registration, we'll get to know things like how many children are in your family, what allergies your child(ren) may have, and the best way to contact you. Once you are registered and checked in, both you and your child(ren) will receive a set of stickers with a matching code, also known as a "security tag". On the tag, you will also find your child's corresponding room. This sticker is what you'll use to pick up your child after the service. If, for any reason, we need to reach you, you will receive a text directly to the number we have on your account indicating the need!

Drop-Off/Pick-Up

Once your child(ren) are checked in and arrive at the room printed on their sticker, our leaders will be ready to greet your family and engage your child in an age-appropriate activity. At the end of the service, a team member will verify that your security tag code matches the code on your child's tag before he/she is released into your care. In the event of a lost sticker, we will use your driver's license as an alternative to the security tag to verify information and check out your child.

Safety

In FFC Kids Kids, we are committed to safety, and it is the heart of our children's ministry to make every effort to ensure the safety and well-being of every child.

With this in mind, we do not allow anyone into our classrooms without a corresponding security tag, and all team members serving in a FFC Kids area go through a screening process before serving. All team members serving in FFC Kids are background-checked and trained in safety and security protocols.

Once in our care, a child is not allowed to be picked up by anyone who does not have a sticker with the code that coincides with the one on his/her sticker. If a security tag has been lost, photo identification must be presented and matched with the guardian information on the registered account. If a need arises or you have any questions, please contact a staff member and they will be happy to assist you.

Series Topics

1	August - Design	When you look at the world, what do you see? Vast oceans teeming with extraordinary sea life? Flowers you can name by their scent? Trees that blossom in spring, produce fruit in summer, and turn brilliant colors in fall? When God saw everything He had made, it was very good. And it still is!
2	September - Identity	God had plans when He made the sun, moon, and stars. God had plans when He made rain fall and plants grow. God had plans when He filled the ocean and land with animals. So why would we doubt that God has plans for the one thing He created in His very own image?

The best gifts are the ones that require sacrifice on the part of the giver. That’s what makes Jesus the most incredible gift. God gave us His Son, Jesus.
6	January - Truth	There are a lot of books that teach a lot of things. But there is only one book that teaches the best things – things like how to live for God, hear from God, pray to God, and talk about God to others. We can find all of those best things in the Bible!

7	February - Connection	Love is a word used for many things. We love chocolate. We love puppies. We love naps. But the love Jesus gives us is in a category all by itself. It's a love that is greater than any other love. It's a love that Jesus has for everyone, and it will never end.
8	March - Transformation	When you see something that you have never seen before, and you cannot explain how it happened, that falls into the "amazing" category. That's what people experienced when Jesus began teaching and doing miracles. They had never seen or heard anyone like Him. Jesus was amazing then, and Jesus is amazing now!
9	April - Restoration	We can be forgiven because of what Jesus did on the cross. We can be with Jesus forever because the tomb is empty. We have so much to celebrate! Jesus is alive! And Jesus wants to be our friend forever! News that is this good is too good to keep to ourselves!
10	May - Compassion	Think about all the people in this world. People like you. People who are nothing like you. People who have made great choices. People who have made horrible choices. 1	August - Faith	We can trust God. Looking back at the beginning of God's Big Story and seeing how God kept His promises then gives us confidence to trust that He will be with us now.
